### INCIDENT INVOLVING BURN INJURIES AT 320 WEST 200 NORTH IN KAYSVILLE

On April 5, 2018, at 1359 hours, police officers were dispatched to a suicide threat at the Chevron located at 320 West 200 North in Kaysville. Dispatch reported that a man had poured gasoline on himself in the bathroom of the convenience store. Officers tried to restrain the male to get a lighter from his hand. The male then ignited the gasoline with the lighter. The male and several officers were injured. Our thoughts and prayers go out to all those injured. We appreciate your patience as we attempt to contact the loved ones of all those injured in this incident.

The male was taken by helicopter to the hospital with severe burn injuries. Four officers were also taken by ambulance to local hospitals with varying degrees of injuries. The scene has been stabilized and Kaysville detectives are conducting further investigation into the incident.

Further information will be released as it becomes available. We are grateful to the Kaysville Fire Department, Farmington Fire Department, Layton Fire Department, Davis County Sheriff's Office, Utah Highway Patrol, Syracuse Police Department, Farmington Police Department, Clinton Police Department, and ATF, who all responded and assisted.
