Concussion Information

- In the first legislative session of 2011, the state of Utah followed in the footsteps of the state of Washington – which in May of 2009 signed into law HB 1824 – Zackery Lystedt Law – by passing House Bill 204: Protection of Athletes with Head Injuries. In March of 2011 Governor Herbert signed the bill into law.
- Within weeks of the law taking effect Kaysville Parks & Recreation started the process of becoming fully compliant with this new law. KPR fully supports any and all measures that will help protect our athletes from the very real and very dangerous affects of concussions.

Concussion Education

- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention created a free online concussion training tool for coaches.
- As a coach for Kaysville Parks and Recreation you are required to take part in the 45 minute training.
- When you have completed the training you will receive a certificate of completion.
- A copy of the certificate must be delivered to the recreation office via email, mail or hand delivered. Keep a copy for your records.
