



Metering Project 2023

Dear Resident,

As part of a larger regional effort to more effectively manage water supplies and continue to provide secondary water service that you enjoy, Benchland Water District will be installing secondary water meters in your neighborhood.

The District will have construction crews in your area between January 2023 and July 2023 to install these meters. We anticipate minimal interruption to your secondary water service and some digging near your secondary water line connection to complete the installation. Upon completion of the installation, site conditions will be restored to the pre-construction condition. Most work will take place within the park strip area between the curb and the sidewalk. Please note that sod restoration may happen at a date later than the meter installation, depending on supplies, weather conditions, and time of year.

This project includes:

-The installation of a secondary water meter that will provide you and the District with information regarding monthly usage.

Secondary Water Metering Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Why are you installing meters?

Up to this point, we have not been able to inform you of your secondary water useage. The new meter will help us understand and provide accurate data to make informed decisions about current and future water use demands. Bill HB242 is a bill that was passed in the Utah legislature and signed into law last session. It requires that all Utah secondary water laterals be metered by 2030.

Will I be able to notice the meter after the installation?

After the meter is installed, you will notice a 12 inch diameter purple lid covering the meter box. This is similar to your culinary water meter lid and box. The lid will be flush with the ground surface.

Will you dig up my yard?

A small area on either side of your sidewalk and/or park strip will be excavated to install the meter. The area disturbed will be restored to the condition it was found. Sod or turf may be replaced in the event of damage.

What do I have to do and will it cost me any money?

You do not need to do anything. There is no cost to you, as the District will be purchasing and installing these meters.

When will this work happen?

Construction crews will work to install meters between January 2023 through July 2023.
