

# CURBSIDE RECYCLING



## Acceptable Recyclable Items

- **Paper:** brochures, catalogs, computer paper, junk mail, magazines, mixed office paper, newspaper, telephone books, wrapping paper.
- **Cardboard (flattened/cut):** cereal boxes, drink cartons, food boxes/cartons, gift boxes, tissue boxes, milk/juice cartons, paper bags, pizza boxes.
- **Plastics 1-7 (cleaned):** clear/colored bottles, food/juice bottles, milk jugs, plastic bottles/containers, grocery bags, soda pop bottles, water jugs/bottles, laundry jugs/bottles, lids.
- **Metals:** aluminum cans, aluminum pans, steel cans, tin cans, various good cans.

## Unacceptable Recyclable Items

- **Food & Liquid Waste:** Leftover food, food scraps, peels.
- **Non-Recyclable Plastics:** Styrofoam, plastic toys, disposable diapers.
- **Glass:** Glass bottles/jars.
- **Green Waste:** grass clippings, tree clippings, yard waste, debris.
- **Other:** aerosol cans, aluminum foil, car batteries, china/ceramics, clothing, construction wood, cookware, household hazardous waste, light bulbs/tubes, paper plates/cups, small appliances, wax paper, wire hangers.

## Recycling Tips:

- Rinse containers before recycling.
- Remove plastic lids and caps from bottles.





# CURBSIDE RECYCLING

## How Kaysville City Curbside Recycling Works

- Your blue recycling container must be used only for acceptable recyclable materials. Recyclables can be co-mingled or mixed together in one container.
- The recycling calendar (found on the city's website) shows red and blue weeks on the same day as your trash day.
- Please have your recycling container out to the curb by 6:00 AM or the night before. Routes change from time to time and your container(s) may be some of the first collected that day. By combining recycling collection with the collection of regular garbage pickup, times may be altered.
- Place the container in the street with the wheels against the curb or within 2 feet of the blacktop if no curb exists, with the front of the container facing the street. Containers must be placed 4 feet apart and 8 feet from mailboxes, poles, fences, trees, or parked vehicles for easy access. Do not place cans under low trees or other overhead obstructions.
- The container has an inventory number which is assigned to each household. Customers are responsible for the containers delivered to their address. The container must remain on your property and be properly cared for. If containers are lost or stolen the homeowner will be charged for a replacement container. Please leave the can at your residence when you move.
- Just like regular garbage pickup, there is no pickup of recyclables on July 4, Memorial Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, or New Year's Day. If your pickup day falls on one of these holidays, it will be picked up the next day. For those collected on the remaining days of a holiday week, please place your container out on the regular day, then be patient. Garbage collection will be back on schedule as soon as possible.
- Additional recycling containers are available for an additional monthly fee per container and must be kept at least 6 months.
